

95 Avenue Temporary Full Closure Effective April 28, 2019

As part of construction for the Valley Line LRT, 95 Avenue will be temporarily closed from 85 Street to Connors Road for major work activities. This temporary full closure allows TransEd to return completed roads and sidewalks back to the community a full year ahead of schedule, now expected to re-open by the end of 2019. Pedestrian access along 95 Avenue will be maintained throughout this closure.

TransEd heard from the community and is working to address the concerns. Initiatives are being developed in conjunction with the local businesses and the Strathearn Community League. Look for advertising, events and promotions in Strathearn this year to support local businesses.

In 2020, landscaping and some works contained within the rail alignment will be completed, with significantly less disruption to the community.

ABOUT THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE

- » There will be no impact to garbage and recycling collection.
- » Emergency Services will have access through the construction zone to reach the front of properties, if needed, or through back alleys on 95 Avenue.
- » Address signs will be installed in back alleys to help Emergency Services, visitors and delivery services to find properties.
- » Canada Post will divert mail delivery to properties without front access. Please look for information directly from Canada Post.

EASING ACCESS IN AND OUT OF THE NEIGHBOURHOOD

- » During school hours, there will be no parking on either side of 93 Avenue at 85 Street to allow the Ecole Gabrielle-Roy school buses to use 93 Avenue.
- » Intermittently, there will be a right-in-right-out at Strathearn Drive along northbound Connors Road.
- » 87 Street will be reduced to one lane. Northbound traffic must yield to oncoming traffic.

ETS SERVICE WILL BE IMPACTED EFFECTIVE APRIL 28, 2019

- » Bus stops 2334 and 2246 will be relocated to either end of the closure on 95 Avenue.
- » Bus stops 2585 and 2312 at Montgomery Legion Place will be maintained for the duration of the road closure.
- » All other bus stops on 95 Avenue will be temporarily closed during the full road closure.
- » TransEd will run a shuttle during peak hours, seven days a week, to help those with mobility issues to access the relocated bus stops. Visit transedlrt.ca for details.
