

EDMONTON'S VALLEY LINE SOUTHEAST TRAIN SAFETY

The Valley Line Southeast low-floor trains are now testing along the 13-kilometer LRT alignment from Mill Woods to Downtown.

The train systems testing process is to ensure that all elements are performing to required standards before opening to the public. For your safety:

Road users will be sharing the road with train/LRT.

Be aware of your surroundings and other road users. Stay alert while on the road.

Flag persons are on-site for the safety of the public, their crews, and themselves to ensure that everyone gets to the destinations safely.

Always follow the direction of construction personnel and flaggers.

The overhead wires are energized at different areas along the entire 13-kilometre alignment. Always assume that these wires are live.

Be aware that coming into contact with live overhead wires can lead to serious injury or death.

Keep all high reaching devices such as ladders, outdoor banner/light installation poles, drones, and remote-controlled planes away from the energized overhead wires.

Always follow traffic and pedestrian signs and signals.

Pedestrians should be aware of their surroundings at all times.

Pay attention to pedestrian signals that will permit you to cross safely at intersections.
